





Russell Group remains the dominant destination, showing steady growth across the period.

Oxbridge numbers are stable but relatively small, highlighting its highly selective intake.

Top-ranked non-Russell institutions rise modestly, reflecting broader appeal outside the Russell Group.

London (non-Russell) remains consistent, suggesting sustained demand for capital-based universities.






International destinations fluctuate, peaking mid-period before softening in 2025.

Other UK institutions show gradual decline, possibly indicating shifting prestige or student choice.

STEM attracts the largest share, maintaining yearon-year strength and driving overall growth. Business & Law show consistent appeal, second only to STEM in scale, demonstrating the strength of Business at Wrekin.

Social Sciences remain stable, though growth lags behind STEM and Business.
