


OUR LOCATION

We welcome applications from families seeking a high-quality British education with strong pastoral care. To support access, Wrekin College offers:

- Scholarships and awards for highachieving international students
- Clear academic packages, including pathways tailored to English proficiency levels
- Short-stay and summer school programmes that provide a taste of life at Wrekin and often lead to fulltime enrolment
- A seamless admissions process, with dedicated support for parents and agents to guide them through each stage



APPLICATION PROCESS

A SIMPLE AND SUPPORTIVE PATH TO JOINING WREKIN

- Enquiry: Agents can initiate the admissions process by contacting the admissions team via email at admissions@wrekincollege.com or by phone at +44 (0)1952 265645.
- Registration: Applicants complete a registration form and pay a £100 registration fee. Tours of the school can be arranged in person or virtually.
- Assessments: Conducted throughout the year. Non-native English speakers are required to take an English as a Foreign Language (EFL) assessment.
- Acceptance and Confirmation: Offers are made based on school reports, interviews, and assessments. Places are confirmed with the Acceptance Form and deposit.
